ACCESSIBILITY IN HUSET-KBH

Copenhagen Pride should be for the entire LGBTI+ community! We recognise that we are not there yet when it comes to accessibility, but we are committed to working on it. If you have any questions or comments, please write to us at kontakt@copenhagenpride.dk.

The majority of Winter Pride Week will take place at Huset-KBH, located at Rådhusstræde 13 in the centre of Copenhagen. All venues in Huset-KBH are wheelchair accessible. Note that there are cobblestones in the courtyard.

Huset-KBH is on 4 floors. There is access to the ground floor (5 steps up from the entrance) and floors 1-4 via a staff-operated lift. During Winter Pride, there will be a Copenhagen Pride info booth at the entrance with volunteers who can help you find the right venue.

The toilet facilities are located on the ground floor on the same level as Bastard Café. The toilet is a small accessible toilet

As you need to use the lift to enter the building and when you need to get around the building to get to the toilet facilities, for example, it is advisable to contact us in advance at **kontakt@copenhagenpride.dk** and let us know when you are coming. You can also ring us at **+45 93977986** from 19-23 February between 16.30 - 21.30

It is permitted to bring a guide dog in Huset-KBH.

Huset-KBH does not have its own parking spaces, so you must use the public disabled parking spaces in the area. There are two close to the main entrance off Løngangsstræde 16 and one off Gåsestræde 1. The spaces are narrow but have a good length.

Distance to bus 2A, 23, 31, 37 (Stormbroen): 170 m

This panel explores the challenges faced by LGBTI+ individuals in conflict zones. Through personal stories and research insights, we delve into the resilience of queer communities, highlighting the role of queer people as advocates and agents of change. The discussion addresses the contributions of queer perspectives to conflict resolution and humanitarian efforts, emphasising the need for inclusive policies. Join us for an exploration of the intersection of queerness and war.

THE 'UGLY LAW' AND THE HUNT FOR THE HUSTLERS

In the 1960s, the vice squad's campaign against male prostitution in Copenhagen culminated in the so-called 'Ugly Law', which criminalised homosexual buyers of sex. The campaign turned views on prostitution, homosexuality and gender equality upside down. Historian Peter Edelberg will talk about the time and how prostitution is not only unambiguous, but also a concept used by the state to regulate relationships between people. THURSDAY 22 FEBRUARY

What is my neurotype and how do I navigate the system and the norms? Neurodivergence is a broad concept that covers autism, ADHD, NLD, dyslexia, dyscalculia, etc. There is a large overlap between neurodivergence and gender identity, eg. 15% of autistic people define themselves as transgender or nonbinary. How does it feel to be a neurodivergent LGBTI+person? We talk about the challenges we face based on our own lived experiences.

Many Bi+ people are met differently according to the gender of their current partner. Bi+ people are often invisible if in relationships perceived as heterosexual. Bi+ identities are pressured or lost. Within both straight and queer settings it can be difficult to sustain one's Bi+ identity. When

society frames life after the gender of a present partner, parts of one's life story seem erased. Alienation and loneliness arises. The debate opens different perspectives and life experiences of Bi+ people.

In Denmark, permanent residence permits are hard to obtain, and refugees must reapply for a new temporary residence permit every year or two. The panel features LGBTI+ refugees who will share their experiences with living in this uncertainty, and the panel will present solutions.


